

Computer/Wireless Internet Use Policy

Policy

1. Must show government issued photo id or library card for the Morgan County Library (Applications have a copy of patron's driver's license on the back.)
2. Person must be in good standing with the library with no outstanding fines or materials in order to use wifi or public computers.
3. Household members will lose privileges until household is clear of letter and materials fines. Household lose privileges when materials are over 8 weeks late.
4. One hour of public computer use per day.
5. Librarians will provide limited assistance to patrons/public with their own computers or library public computers.
6. No cell phone use in the library or on the public computers without permission.
7. Pornographic or illicit site use will not be tolerated. All library privileges will be revoked permanently if these types of sites are used. The patron will immediately lose all library privileges and be told to leave library property. The patron can approach the Board after one year to request reinstatement; it will be the discretion of the Board of Trustees to reinstate all or partial library privileges.
