

Trustee Nominee Information

The Board of Trustees is the governing body of Morgan County Library. Its role is to set policies for the conduct of the Board and the operation of the library, monitor the district's financial condition, and employ the Director.

Board Meetings are usually held the second Thursday of each month.

The Board of Trustees shall be composed of 5 members, appointed by the Morgan County Commission. Appointees shall be residents of Morgan County. Trustees shall be appointed for a period of 4 years, from the first day of July following their appointment, and annually thereafter before the first day of July. Suggestions for potential replacements should be discussed among the Board prior to contacting the individual. The Director will submit copies of the Nominee Information form to the County Commission accompanied by a recommendation.
