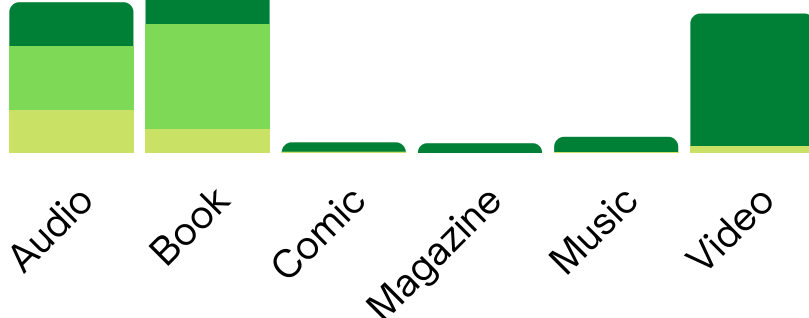

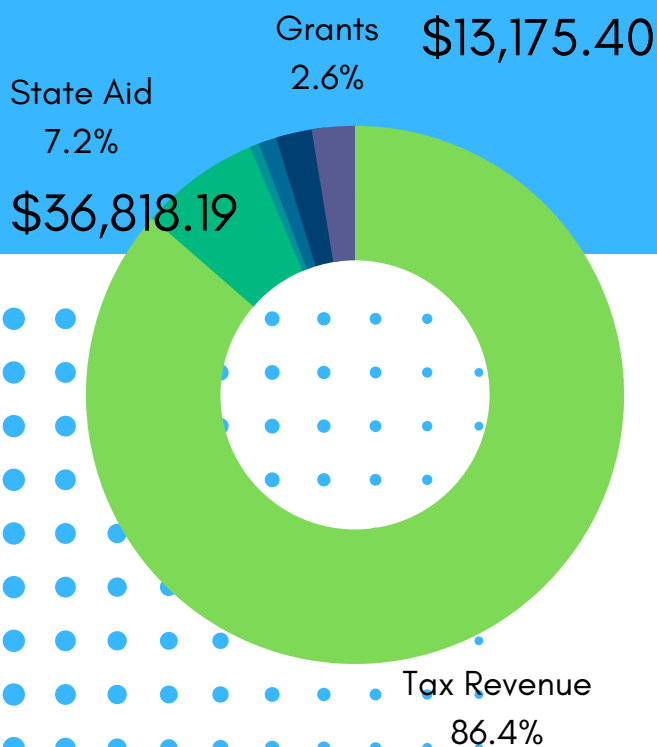
CIRCULATION
